Condition	Sidewinder is now available for the 2024 Silverado RST.
Cause	Sidewinder builds off the already standard four-wheel steering capabilities of RST. Accessed through the infotainment screen, Sidewinder enables all four wheels to turn in the same direction, allowing the truck to move diagonally at speeds up to 20 mph.
Correction	If a customer comes to a dealer and is requesting the Sidewinder feature be enabled, dealer technicians should update the vehicle software per bulletin 24-NA-143.
