- 1. Confirm condition is present, "Settings, Vehicle, Audio Settings, Sound, Sound Mode". If menu opens, issue is not related to this bulletin. If Sound Mode menu opens momentarily, goes blank, and the audio settings menu opens, proceed to step 2.
- 2. Contact the Techline Customer Support Center (TCSC) for related VCI number programming assistance. Reference Bulletin # 25–NA-036.
- 3. Connect a USB-C USB Drive to the computer, perform a quick format on the usb drive to NTFS.
- 4. Launch TLC/SPS2



5. Select A11 Radio, USB File Transfer, VCI

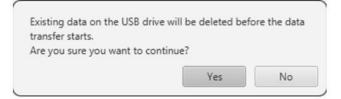


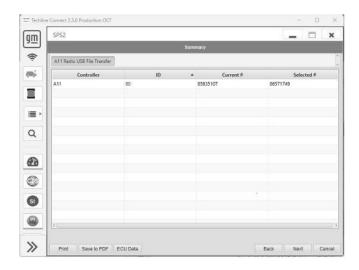
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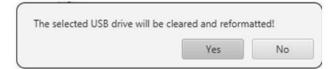
6. Enter USB File Transfer VCI # supplied by TCSC, Select Next











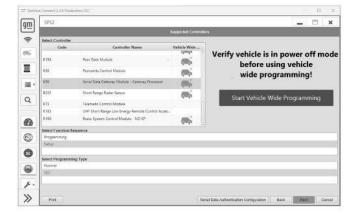




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- 7. Follow on screen instructions
- 8. Select Proceed Same VIN

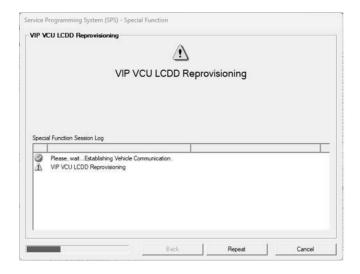


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9. Select Serial Data Gateway Module, Setup, VCI

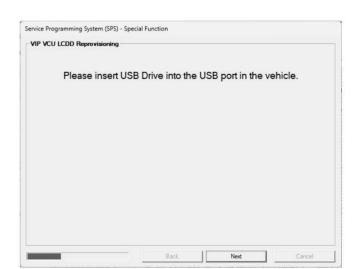


10. Enter VCI # for setup provided by TCSC, select Next



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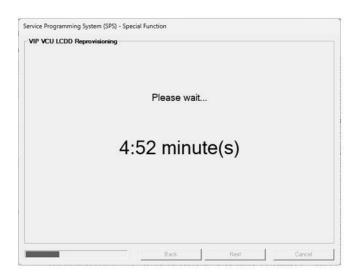
11. Setup Process will begin, repeat screen may present during Run/Service mode procedure. Select "Repeat" if present.





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12. Insert USB Stick into USB-C Port of vehicle





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13. 5 minute timer will begin counting down on SPS, the Radio/cluster display should go black, an "insert USB recovery disk" message will momentarily appear, and then a progress bar will be present (If it does not, allow the 5 minute timer to countdown)





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- 14. Did the screen show programming was a "Success"? If not present after 5 minute timer, Remove USB drive and reinsert, select No, and procedure will reattempt.
- 15. Confirm Sound Mode menu now opens correctly. "Settings, Vehicle, Audio Settings, Sound, Sound Mode". If Sound Mode menu does not open correctly, reattempt procedure from step 3.
