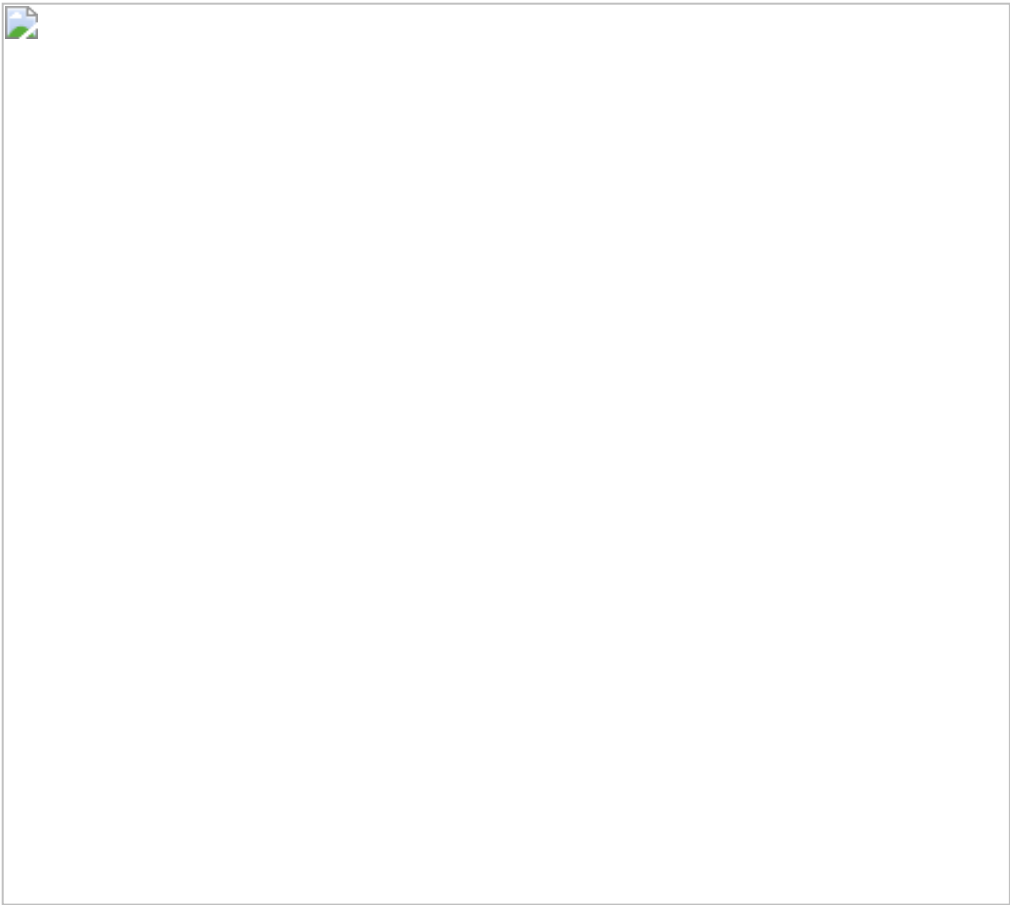

Condition	<p>Some customers may comment of a rattle, squeak, creak, itch, buzz, vibration, or rub type noise heard from the IP dash, drivers floor, accelerator pedal, or center console area.</p> <p>The noise may be duplicated by the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Driving over small bumps at slower speeds- During acceleration- Brake torquing- When engine goes into AFM mode
Cause	The cause of this noise could be the bank 1 sensor 1 O2 sensor connector contacting the body / floor, as shown below.



Correction:
Inspect the bank 1 sensor 1 O2 sensor connector for contact to the body/floor.

If contact is found, then make sure the connectors' plastic retainer is fully installed/seated in the mounting tab hole, this will hold the connector away from the body.
