Today March 7, 2025, Acura is announcing a **product update** for certain model year 2024 ZDX units. The Electric Park Brake (EPB) harness unit may have low clearance to the driveshaft boot resulting in increased wear. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

**REPAIR**

Replace the EPB harness clips and if necessary, replace the driveshaft.

**PARTS**

Parts will be available at launch via the controlled ordering system.

**TOOLS**

There are no new special tools needed for this campaign.

**SERVICE BULLETIN**
