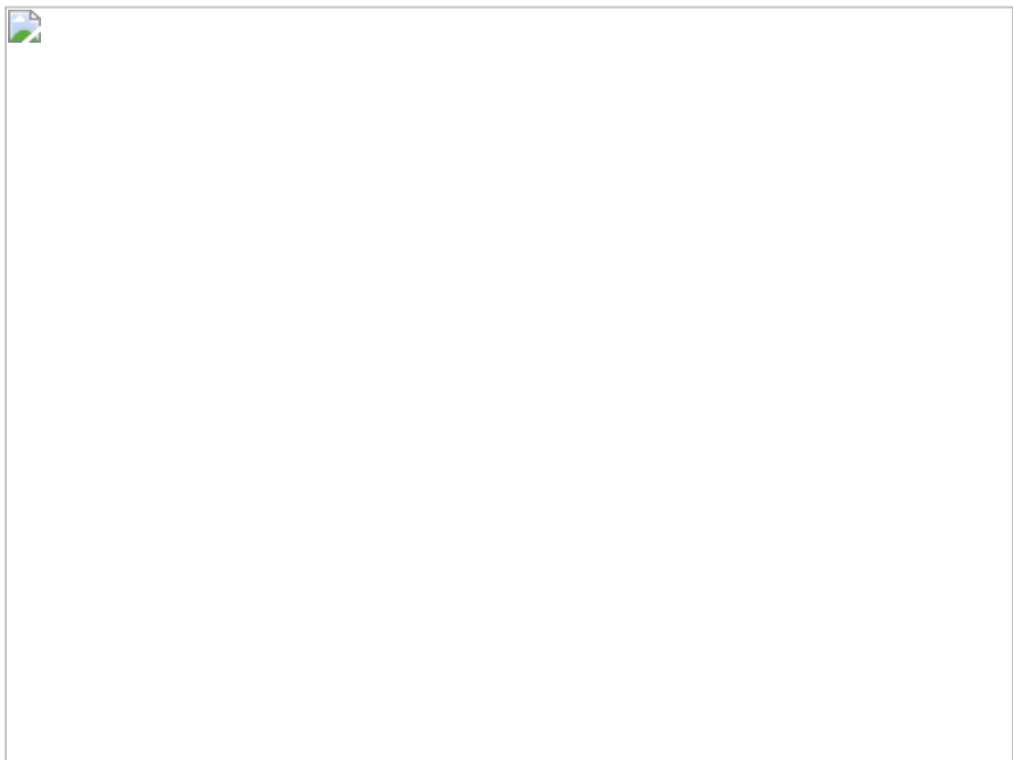

Condition	<p>Customer may comment that the front fascia/bumper trim is coming apart.</p> <p>The technician may find the front bumper fascia is bowed out on one or both sides.</p> <p>Looks like it's trim is hitting the headlamp assembly.</p>
Cause	Front fascia trim is not fully installed onto fascia.

Correction:

Inspect front fascia and confirm that the following condition exists.

RH side shown below.



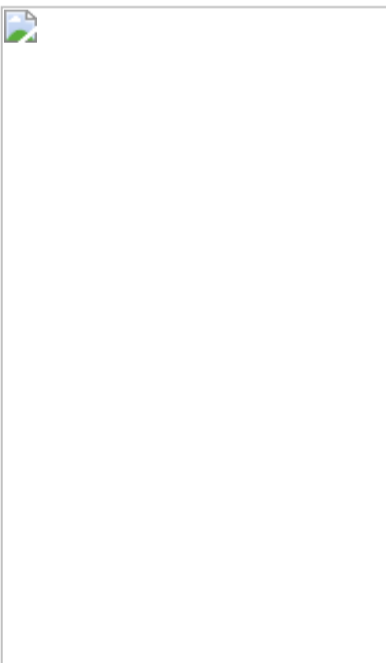
To repair this condition, the tech will need to remove the 4 fasteners location at the top of the fascia, see image below.



Using a trim stick tool, gentle pry upwards.



Pull top of fascia forward.



With the affected trim exposed, inspect for the trim lock tabs.



If the retaining tabs are not fully locked into the fascia, using hand pressure only, lock them into place.
