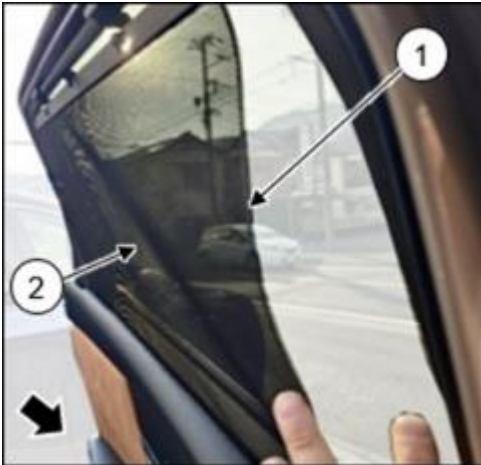

### DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may exhibit sagging (1) at the front side of the rear sunshade(s) (2) or a difference in tension between the front and rear of the sunshade(s). When the rear sunshade is fully pulled up and then hooked up, the front hook's position may be lower, causing sagging on the front side of the rear sunshade.

**NOTE:** The figure shows left side. (same as right side )

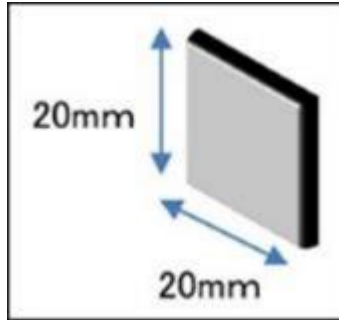

**REPAIR PROCEDURE**

1. Verify the customer concern.
2. Cut the non-woven fabric (Black: 4.84 x 4 x 0.06 inch (250 x 100 x 1.5 mm) in the noise repair kit into 0.8 x 0.8 inch (20 x 20 mm) pieces.

**NOTE:** The figures show left side. (same as right side )

- One rear sunshade: 1 piece
- Both rear sunshades: 2 pieces

3. Pull out the sunshade entirely and hold it in position.

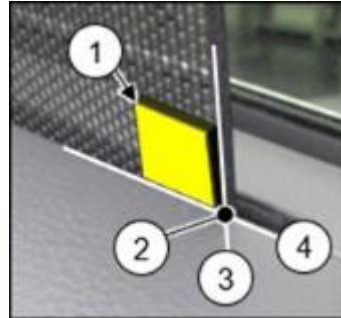

4. Attach the non-woven fabric (1) to the lower front edge (2) of the sunshade as shown in the figures.

- (3) Align the non-woven fabric to the front edge of the sunshade.
- (4) Align the non-woven fabric to the lower edge of the sunshade.

5. Verify the repair by hooking up the sunshade and confirming that there is no sagging.
