The Detroit Assurance suite of safety features is expanding coverage to include compatibility of Adaptive Cruise Control with the Cummins engine portfolio, beginning with the X15 heavy duty engine.

Detroit Assurance Standard Adaptive Cruise Control (ACC), (data codes 736-142, 736-143), will be available for Cummins X15 engines for builds starting mid-April, on the Western Star 49X model. ACC for Cummins X15 will automatically adjust cruising speed to maintain a safe, continuous following distance behind other vehicles down to 10 mph, providing drivers the ability to remain in cruise control longer, experience less fatigue, and stay more alert on the road ahead.

Daimler Truck North America plans to offer ACC for the entire Cummins portfolio available in the Freightliner Plus series and Western Star X-Series models. Please stay up to date on communications and dealer webinars to know when to expect the feature availability for each engine/vehicle platform.
