SITUATION

BMW AG has issued a Delivery Stop (effective February 21, 2025) on a small number of Model Year 2025 BMW vehicles that were produced between January 13, 2025, and February 4, 2025.

Do not deliver to a customer, a New, Certified Pre-Owned or Used vehicle subject to a Delivery Stop, until the vehicle is repaired. Do not use or sell replacement equipment/parts subject to a Delivery Stop.

The parking brake actuator cannot be activated or deactivated due to a failed weld.

Check Control message "Parking brake failed. When parking, secure the vehicle against rolling away. Must be checked by the Service Partner."

The vehicle is still held by the unaffected side and the transmission lock.

CAUSE

Manufacturing error of the parking brake actuator.

CORRECTION

Replace the right parking brake actuator.

PROCEDURE

Replace the right parking brake actuator as per REP 34 52 162.
