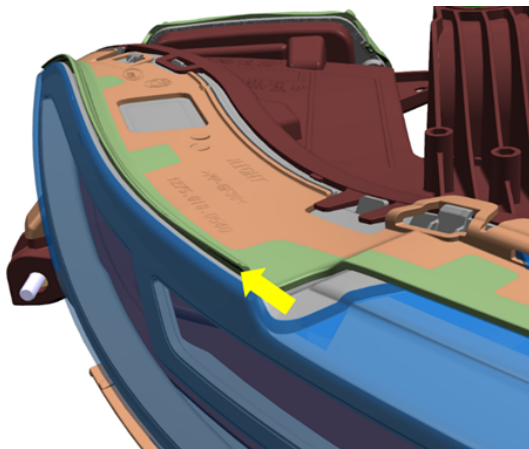
**SITUATION**



Contamination/condensation in the upper section of the Daytime Running Lights (DRL) headlight(s); driver’s headlamp shown.

**Note: This situation only occurs on G07 LCI vehicles with crystal headlights.**

**CAUSE**



The crystal DRL headlights have a transparent upper channel that may collect moisture/debris over time. This becomes visible to the customer.

**CORRECTION**

Clean the moisture/debris in the upper channel of the DRL headlight(s).

**PROCEDURE**

1. Verify the customer’s concern.



2. Using a cleaning swab, clean the upper channel on the DRL headlight(s).

**Note: The cleaning can be done with the headlight installed in the vehicle.**

Note: Do not use a heat gun to remove any moisture due to risk of deforming the headlamp housing plastic.
