Condition	Some customers may complain of a Service AWD message on the DIC. A C11B7.96, C0090.72 or C0095.72 DTC may be set.
Cause	A software issue within the Rear Differential Clutch Control Module (K47B Power Transfer Unit Actuator Control Module / DSAM-Driveline Smart Actuator Module).

The ECM controls the Rear Differential Clutch Control Module.

Verify the ECM has the latest update. Perform an ECM update if available. Clear the DTC.

If the C11B7.96, C0090.72 or C0095.72 DTC returns, do not replace the Rear Differential Clutch Control Module. Engineering is working towards a resolution but is not available yet. This PI will be updated when more information is available.
