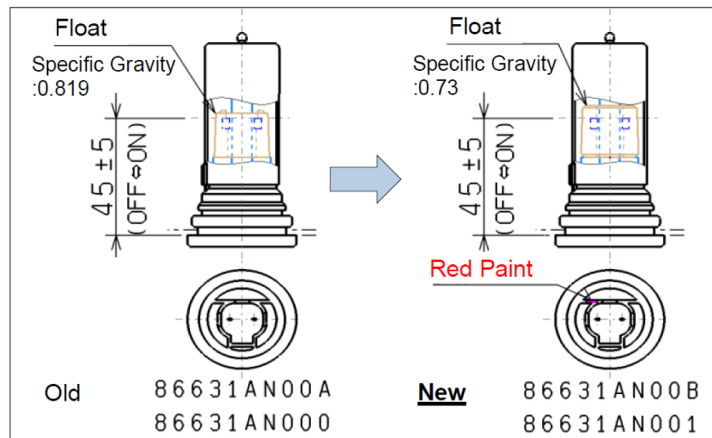
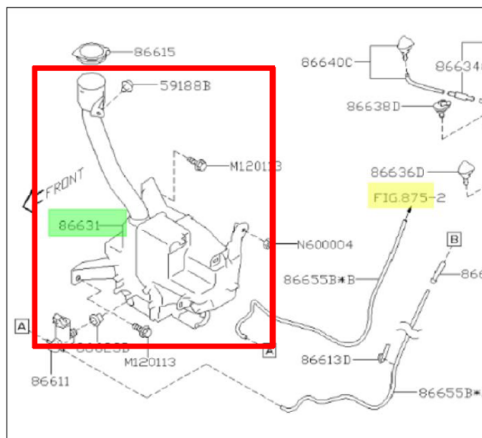

INTRODUCTION:

This bulletin announces the design change made to the Washer Tank. The updated washer tank now features an enhanced level sensor. Previously, the low washer fluid warning light on the instrument cluster would occasionally illuminate despite the fluid level being adequate. The new level sensor's float is designed to resist fluid immersion resulting in more accurate readings.
