CLUSTER WITH DTC P0DAB:17 AND/OR P0DAB:00**

APPLICABLE MODEL(S)/VINS

2024 CX-90 MHEV (inline6) with VINS between JM3KK*****100044 - 170926 (produced between (December 27, 2022 - April 24 2024)

DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may experience the CHECK ENGINE light ON and the message "ENGINE HYBRID SYSTEM AND i-STOP MALFUNCTION" displayed in the instrument cluster with one or both of the following DTCs:

- P0DAB:17 is set in the MHB module.
- P0DAB:00 is set in the SGC2/DMCM module.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

1. Check for DTCs and confirm if DTC P0DAB:00 and/or P0DAB:17 are present.

Is recall 7024J open?

- **YES:** Go to: step 2.
- **NO:** Replace the MHEV battery (refer to the part information below) according to the instructions on MGSS (M Hybrid Boost BATTERY REMOVAL/INSTALLATION [H3T]), then go to step 4.

2. If one or both DTCs are present, replace the MHEV battery (refer to the part information below) according to the instructions on MGSS (M Hybrid Boost BATTERY REMOVAL/INSTALLATION [H3T]).

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3. After the MHEV battery is replaced, perform recall 7024J and any open recalls.

IMPORTANT: If the customer's vehicle is down due to the MHEV battery backorder, make sure any open recalls are performed and closed, then wait until the battery arrives before fully closing out the customer's RO.

4. Test drive the vehicle and verify no other DTC's or symptoms are present.

PARTS INFORMATION

Warranty Policy exception for Mild Hybrid Battery MHEV CX-90 and CX-70

- **Exception:** If DTC P0DAB:17 is set in the mild hybrid battery (MHB) module and/or P0DAB:00 is set in the SGC2/DMCM module, MASH authorization is not required for the first warranty replacement. Otherwise, any other DTC of the MHEV battery, or a second failure with these codes occurs again requires MASH authorization. Review Mazda Warranty Policies and Procedures Policy No.:3.28 for details.

NOTE: If your customer is impacted by the MHEV battery backorder, please refer to the Dealer Communication issued on December 16, 2024. This communication provides customer support options and guidance on utilizing the Mazda Courtesy Vehicle Program (MCVP) until the customer's vehicle can be repaired.
