<b>Condition</b>	A customer may complain that the auto rain sense wipers do not seem to come on soon enough. They may complain that the auto rain-sense wipers stay on high speed too long. They may have general complaints about the auto rain-sense performance.
<b>Cause</b>	Under Investigation.

### Correction

Do not replace any parts for this concern.

Advise the customer that engineering is investigating and working on a design improvement.

Advise the customer that they can disable the rain sense feature if they prefer to have it turned off until a determination has been made.

This can be done through the infotainment screen (Settings>Vehicle>Comfort and Convenience).

The PI will be updated or replaced with TSB once a determination has been made.
