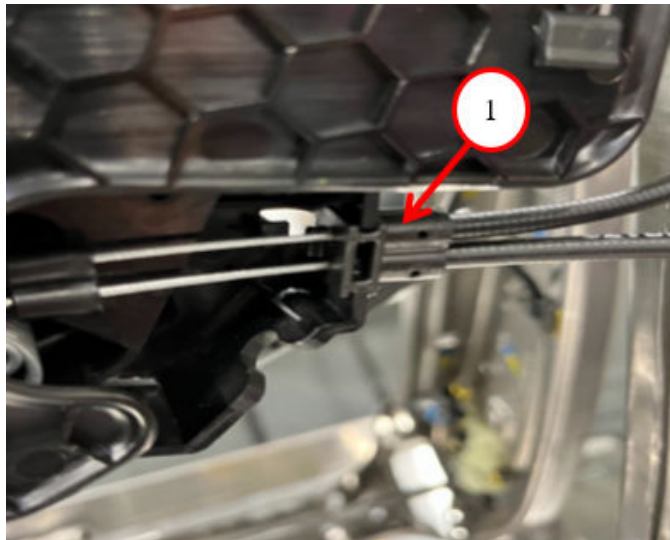
**DIAGNOSIS:**

If the customer describes any of the symptoms listed above in the customer symptom section, perform the Repair Procedure.

**REPAIR PROCEDURE:**

**NOTE: This Repair Procedure can apply to one or both seats. Only repair the seat where the Easy Entry feature is inoperative.**

1. Is the vehicle equipped with a plastic seat back cover?
  - YES>>> Proceed to [Step 2](#).
  - NO>>> Proceed to [Step 3](#).
2. Remove the seat back panel, if equipped. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info> 23 - Body / Seats / Panel, Seat Back / Removal and proceed to [Step 4](#).
3. Unzip the seat back panel cover and proceed to [Step 4](#).
4. Locate the Easy Entry cable end fitting that connects to the ratio box [Fig 1](#).

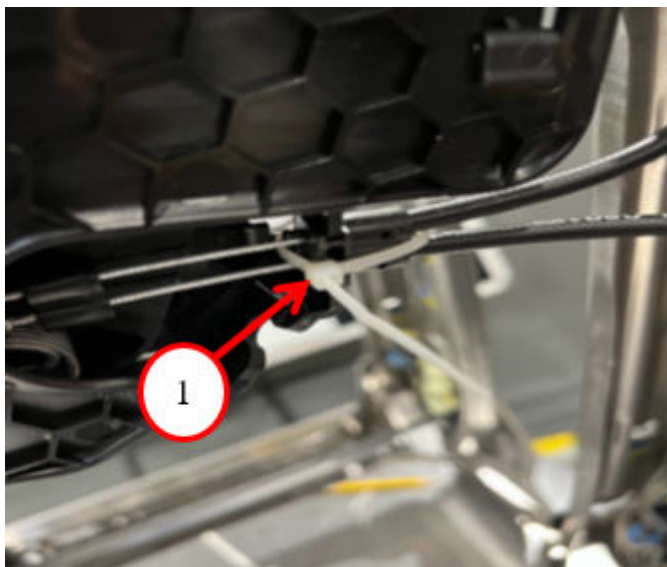

5. Connect the cable connector to the ratio box.

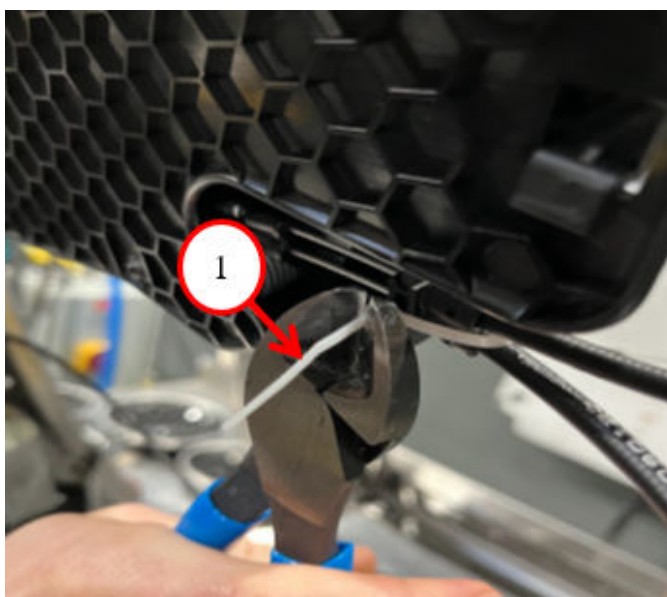
6. Attach a tie strap in between the two cables and around the ratio box connector receptacle [Fig. 2](#).

7. Snip off excess tie strap end [Fig. 3](#).

8. Is the vehicle equipped with a plastic seat back cover?
- YES>>> Proceed to [Step 10](#).
  - NO>>> Proceed to [Step 9](#).
9. Zip the seat back panel cover and proceed to [Step 11](#).
10. Install the seat back panel, if equipped. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info> 23 - Body / Seats / Panel, Seat Back / Installation and then proceed to [Step 11](#).
11. Confirm the Easy Entry seat feature is operational.
