Cause	Engineering has found that there is a high likelihood of one or more of these codes setting due to wire chafe or a poor connection at the sensor or ECM.
Correction	If you find one of these codes in history, it is recommended to follow: Testing for Intermittent Conditions and Poor Connections and Inducing Intermittent Fault Conditions.
