#### SITUATION



The decorative trims on the head restraints of the driver's seat and front passenger seat cause groaning noises on any route, at any temperature, even in a slightly reclined position.

See attached video <u>BV52 01 25 M5 Head</u> <u>Restraint Groaning noise</u> to hear the noise.

## **CAUSE**

The edge of the aperture trim rubs against dry seat leather upholstery at the point of contact.

## **CORRECTION**

Apply leather lotion to the seat leather to eliminate the sticking against the aperture trim.

## **PROCEDURE**



If the decorative trim causes groaning noises, apply leather lotion to the area where the decorative trim comes into contact with the leather (highlighted in yellow).

This can be done without any seat disassembly.

Even if the customer only mentions that the noise comes from one seat, apply the leather lotion to both the passenger and driver's seat leather.
