FUEL GAUGE SWITCH AND CALIBRATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. The Momentary on/off fuel gauge rocker switch can be replaced with a regular on/off switch.
2. Make sure that if the new regular on/off Inside fuel gauge switch is installed, that it always remains in the "on" position except during long term trailer storage.
3. Make sure all power has been removed from the trailer (120-volt and 12-volt battery power) – while the fuel gauge switch in the "on" position.
 - a. The battery needs to be physically disconnected for this process.
4. Restore 12-volt power to trailer after 5 minutes of trailer being disconnected from all 12-volt power.
5. This initiates the re-configuration of the outside fuel system controller when 12-volt power is re-connected.
6. Turn on outside fuel station. This will reconfigure the inside fuel gauge and automatically calibrate to work with the connected outside fuel gauge.
 - a. Please make sure the inside gauge switch is turned to the "on" position.
 - b. Repeat the calibration if inside fuel gauge is switched to the "off" position.
