Recommended Fuel Pump Type for Diesel Units

Tiffin Motorhomes recommends that all diesel units be refueled using standard automotive-grade diesel fuel pumps, rather than high-flow commercial truck stop pumps. The fuel delivery rate from commercial truck stop pumps is often too aggressive for motorhome fuel systems, which are not designed to handle rapid fuel intake. Using high-flow commercial truck stop pumps can result in overflow, spillage, premature shutoff, or even damage to the fuel fill components.

Standard automotive-grade diesel fuel pumps offer a slower, more controlled flow that aligns with the design and capacity of Tiffin's diesel motorhomes. While this may result in a longer fill time compared to commercial truck stop pumps, it ensures a safer and more reliable refueling process and helps maintain the integrity of the fuel system over time.

For units equipped with dual fuel fill locations, it is important to follow proper procedure during refueling. When filling from one side, the opposite fuel fill cap should remain closed and securely tightened. Leaving the opposite side open can disrupt pressure balance and lead to fuel spillage or inaccurate fill readings. Always ensure that only one fill point is used at a time, and that the unused side is properly sealed during the process.

By following these fueling guidelines, owners can avoid unnecessary complications and ensure their motorhome continues to perform at its best.
