Cause	Engineering is currently investigating.

Correction

Do not replace any parts including the K9 Body Control Module or the B174W Front View Camera - Windshield.

Please advise the customer they may continue to drive the vehicle. The current concern may be a potential customer dissatisfier, but it is not a Safety Issue and does not create a substantial loss of use or value.

The PI will be updated or replaced with a TSB once a determination has been made.
