**Issue:**

BMPRO made an unintentional change to their programming at some point in MY2026 that affects the generator functions while the ignition is on. Currently the AGS and START GENERATOR buttons are grayed out while the ignition is on. The generator can be started with the ignition off and then it will stay running when the ignition is turned on. It just can't be started with the ignition already on. The AGS automatically disables, if it's already enabled, when the ignition is turned on as a code requirement. However, with the current programming, it can't be reenabled once the ignition is on.

**Instructions:**

BMPRO has created an update that will fix this. To implement the fix, first the touchscreen will need to be connected to Wifi. Then it should automatically prompt the user to accept an update if it's not already on the newest app. To determine if the app is the correct version, go into the settings and tap on About SYSTEM. Under APP it should say Build Number: 55. If the number is lower than 55, it needs to be updated. Once the screen is updated, it should automatically bring in the new floorplan file. Then all three generator buttons should stay active regardless of the state of the ignition.
