❖ **Summary**

In an ongoing effort to clarify troubleshooting procedures and improve customer uptime, DTNA's Service Engineering Team has revised the diagnostic procedures guidelines for Power Steering Tank Venting.

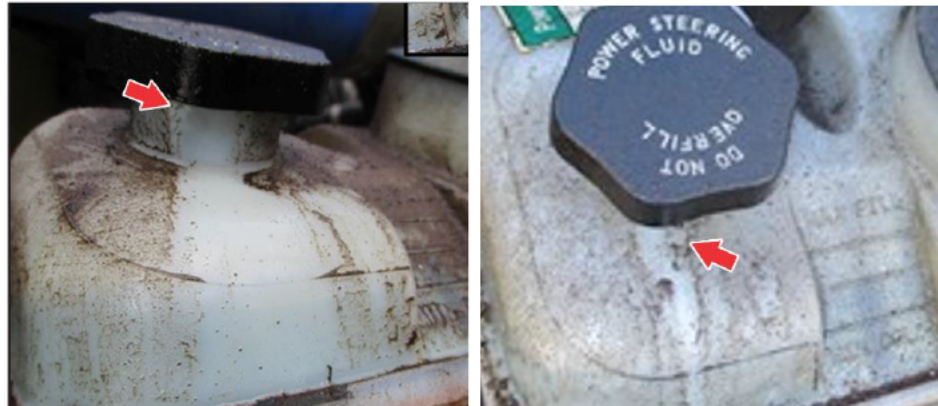
❖ **New Repair Guidelines**

As of July 31, 2025, revisions to the CEEA-CEEA+ Troubleshooting Guide, 5.12.4 Power Steering Tank Venting Diagnostics procedures have clarified diagnostic criteria for power steering tank concerns. These updates specify that oil misting on the tank's exterior is considered a normal condition caused by venting. The updated procedures also provide improved guidelines on cap-related failures.

New Guidelines:

| Condition | Procedure |
|--------------------|------------------------------|
| Misting | Normal condition, clean tank |
| Broken/missing cap | Replace cap |
