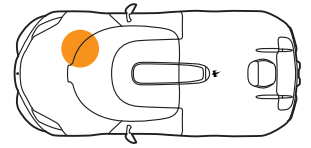




## Replace the Power Steering Pump Fuse

This instruction refers to other documents that are necessary to do the procedure.

This instruction is applicable to the RHD and LHD vehicle. The illustrations show the LHD vehicle.



### Situation

An updated fuse has been implemented to improve the power steering system performance during extended full lock operation.

### Action

Install the new fuse for the power steering pump and attach a new fuse list label.

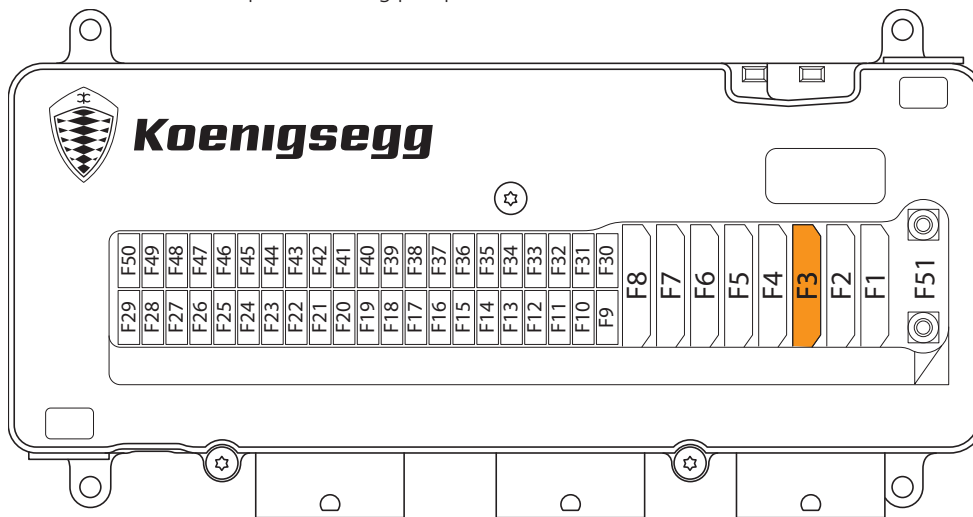

### Prepare

1. Move the passenger seat to its most rearward position
2. Disconnect the 12 V system, refer to [WOM-00007](#).
3. Disconnect the HV system, refer to [WOM-00021](#).
4. Access the PDM1, refer to [WOM-00038](#).

### Remove

1. Find the fuse F3 for the power steering pump.



2. Remove and discard the fuse F3.
3. Install the new fuse to the F3 position.

## Replace the Sticker for PDM1

1. Clean the surface on the foot plate.
2. Make sure that you have the latest revision of the fuse list label.
3. Attach the new fuse list label to the foot plate at the same position as the previous label.

Do not remove the previous label. Attach the new label on the previous label.
