<b>Condition</b>	Some Chevrolet and GMC vehicles equipped with the 8T45 MGH or VT40 MRQ automatic transmission may experience: No drive and or no reverse and a SES light on with code/s P07E5 and or P073E after an Over The Air update.
<b>Cause</b>	Engineering is investigating the concern.

### Correction

If the vehicle has a customer concern of no drive and/or no reverse with a SES light on and DTC(s) P07E5 and/or P073E set current/history, then perform the following:

Clear DTCs using GDS2, disconnect the MDI2 from the vehicle, allow the vehicle to power down for 10 minutes and then retest the vehicle to see if the concern returns.

If the concern is resolved after the above procedure, then no additional diagnostics is necessary, and no hardware replacements are necessary. Vehicle can be released to customer.

If the concern does return, then follow normal SI diagnostics.
