### Details on the introduction of E10 fuel which contains 10% ethanol and its usage on Bentley products

- All vehicles produced post 1990 Model year can be run using E10 fuel

- All vehicles produced before 1990 Model year MUST NOT use E10 fuel



**Maintain the use of E5 (Super Unleaded equivalent) on all products where possible**
