Environmental Precautions for Dealer Inventory

This bulletin provides guidance on proper storage practices for Maserati vehicles in dealer inventory to minimize deterioration of premium interior components (leather, wood and carbon fiber).

MODELS AFFECTED: ALL

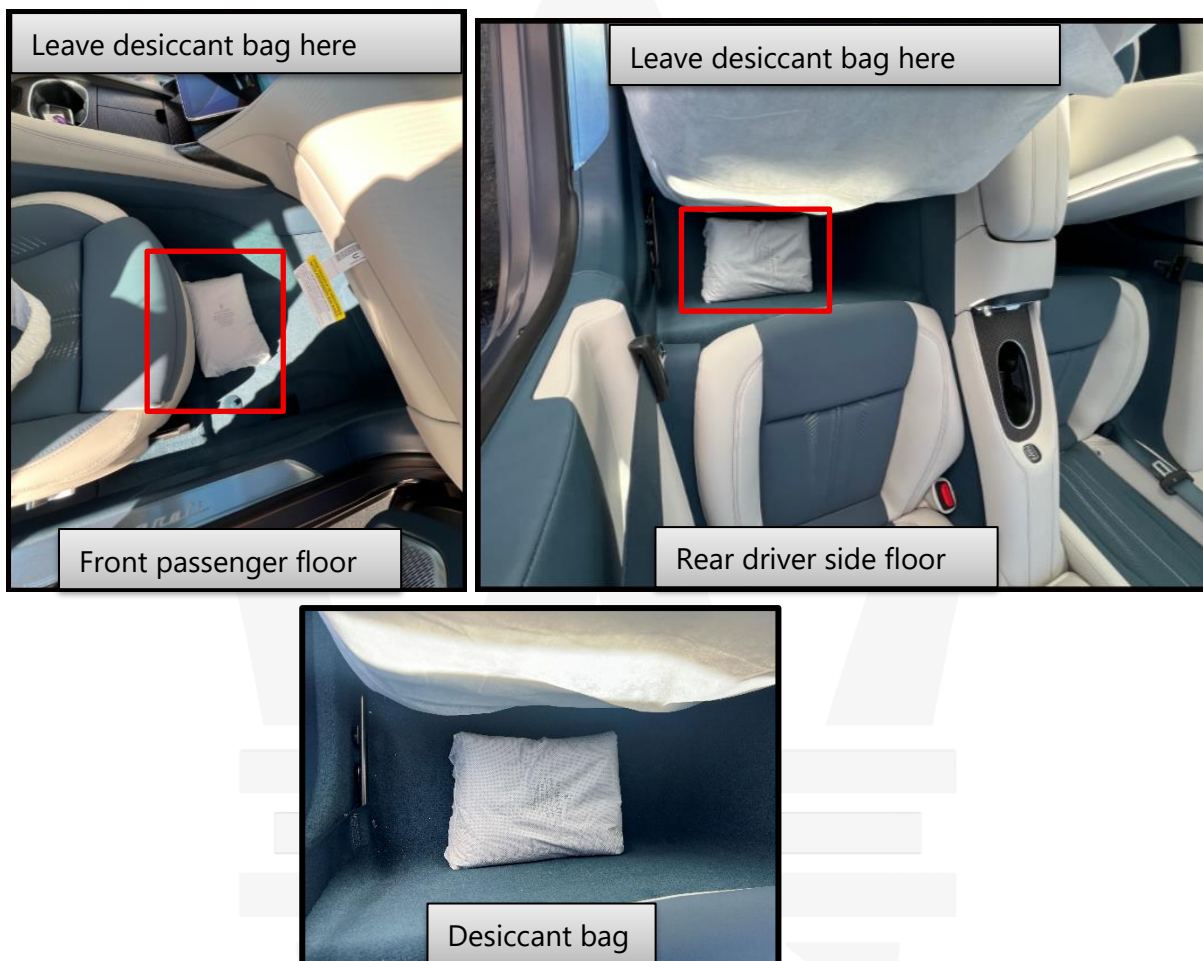
Description

Maserati vehicles, as luxury automobiles, utilize natural premium materials for interior components such as carbon fiber, real leather & wood. Unlike traditional synthetic materials used in standard vehicles, these materials are more susceptible to long-term environmental conditions, including heat, humidity and UV exposure.

This bulletin outlines preventive measures for dealerships to protect in-stock vehicles from these risks. For details on Maserati vehicle in-stock storage requirements please see bulletin **MAS004937 PNP 25-05 MGNT And MAINT Of Instock Vehicles**

Dealer Action

1. Avoid prolonged sun exposure for in-stock vehicles.
 - a. Whenever possible, store vehicles indoors or in shaded areas.
2. If outdoor storage is unavoidable, use an approved windscreen sunshade when the vehicle is parked.
3. During PDI do NOT remove the 2 desiccant bags **until** final delivery inspection (i.e. customer delivery)
 - a. Leave 1 on passenger front floor mat and the 2nd one on the driver's rear floor mat.
 - i. See pictures below for placement
 - ii. **NOTE: DO NOT LEAVE ON SEATS**



Additional Notes

- This precaution applies to all vehicles in dealer inventory prior to retail delivery.
- Refer to the Owner's Manual for leather care recommendations if conditioning is required.
- Desiccant (moisture-absorbing) bags are installed during pre-delivery to reduce humidity inside the vehicle while it is in transit and storage. Keeping interior moisture low helps prevent condensation-related issues such as musty odors, interior fogging, corrosion on electrical connectors, and cosmetic concerns (e.g., spotting on interior trim or glass).
- Dealer storage guidance: For in-stock units, leave the desiccant bags in the vehicle during storage to maintain a dry interior environment. Remove and properly dispose of the bags during final delivery preparation and **ensure they are kept away from children and not opened or ingested.**
