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Ontour Seat Cover

- 1) Place a piece of cardboard under the P/S seat ---this is to catch any glue that can fall on the floor.
- 2) Sand the inside of the whole length of the plastic piece on the seat cover.
- 3) Before applying glue on the plastic piece, dry fit the plastic piece onto the metal clip to ensure it fits correctly.
- 4) If the plastic piece fits correct to the metal lip, proceed applying a bead of Loctite 454 to the whole length of the inside portion of the plastic piece.
- 5) Pull the plastic piece-seat cover down and then wrap it back around to secure to the metal lip. Allow the adhesive to cure and bond in place for 5 minutes. If the vehicle needs to be moved after this time, avoid twisting the seat material when entering or exiting the vehicle. Try to sit or stand directly up and do not pivot on the seat or the bond may break.

Although full functional strength is developed in a relatively short time, curing continues for at least 24 hours before full chemical/solvent resistance is developed.
