## Repair Procedure

1. Secure vehicle for service.
2. Install wheel chocks.
3. Open driver's door.
4. Take a picture of the old Vehicle Emission Control Label before removing it.
5. Use a plastic scraper and adhesive remover to remove the Vehicle Emission Control Label (#1 in the image below).
6. Install the new Vehicle Emission Control Label in the same location as the one that was removed (#1 in the image below), ensure the label is straight and all air bubbles are removed.
7. Take a picture of the new Vehicle Emission Control Label installed in the door jamb.
8. Remove wheel chocks.
9. Release the vehicle back into service.
