Correction

Bring vehicle in-doors and let warm-up, after 15 minutes start the vehicle and look for the message on the cluster and observe the Daytime Running Lamps and also the Turn indicator lamps in the headlamps for proper function

If the code clears and the lamps perform as design, Do Not replace the lamps. In the meantime, please advise the customer they may continue to drive the vehicle.

If lamps do not function, follow SI for diagnosis.
