## Customer statement / workshop findings

### Customer Statement

The customer may report that Rear Seat Entertainment BYOC tablets cannot play content from a USBC memory stick because the USB source does not appear in the source menu.

### Workshop findings

Customer findings are verified in the workshop.

The USB media source is not visible in the BYOC source list, and the tablet does not recognise a USBC memory device even when inserted.

No DTCs are stored, and the BYOC unit otherwise functions normally.

## Technical background

The inability to access or play media from a USB-C memory device on BYOC tablets in the U.S. market is not a fault.

Due to CVAA (Twenty-First Century Communications and Video Accessibility Act) regulatory requirements applicable in the United States, the media playback menu from external USB storage is intentionally disabled. Therefore, BYOC tablets in the U.S. market do not support USB mass-storage media playback. This restriction is market-specific and software operates as designed.

### Required Actions

1. Do not perform any hardware or software modification.
2. Explain to the customer that the USB-C media playback function is unavailable due to U.S. regulatory compliance requirements.

**Use streaming applications available on the BYOC tablets where permitted. Use Bluetooth or Wi-Fi-based content transfer where supported.**
