Today, April 3, 2026, American Honda is announcing a **product update** for certain 2023-2025 Accord Hybrid and 2025-2026 Civic Hybrid vehicles. The current radiator guard does not provide adequate protection. Roadway debris can cause damage to the Power Control Unit (PCU) radiator which may lead to coolant leakage, illumination of multiple Malfunction Indicator Lights (MIL), and/or loss of driving force. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

REPAIR

Inspect the PCU radiator guard and if necessary, replace the PCU radiator guard and/or radiator.

PARTS

Parts are available through the normal ordering system.

TOOLS

There are no special tools needed for this campaign.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service Bulletins 26-025, *Product Update: 2023-2025 Accord Hybrid PCU Radiator Guard Inspection* and 26-026, *Product Update: 2025-2026 Civic Hybrid PCU Radiator Guard Inspection* have posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of April 3, 2026. They include inspection, parts, repair, and warranty information related to this campaign.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

American Honda expects to begin customer notification by the end of May 2026.
