Today, April 1, 2026, American Honda is announcing a **product update** for 3 units of model year 2025 Prologue. During the manufacturing process, insufficient silicone was applied to the DC-DC converter which may lead to excessive heat exposure, causing the Power Distribution Control Module (PDCM) to overheat and potentially rendering the system inoperative. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

**REPAIR**

Replace the drive motor power distribution control module.

**PARTS**

Parts are available through the controlled ordering system.

**TOOLS**

There are no special tools needed for this campaign.

**SERVICE BULLETIN**
