This notice is sent to your dealership to advise that Ford Motor Company has decided that certain 2025 - 2026 F53/F59 Stripped Chassis Vehicles with the Hydro-Boost Brake System including the VIN shown below, fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 108 Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment.

On your vehicle, it is possible that your vehicle's brake pedal may not fully return to the rest position after being depressed. As a result, the stop lamps may remain illuminated when the brakes are not in use. Stop lamps that illuminate when the brakes are not in use can increase the risk of a crash.

Ford Motor Company has authorized your Ford dealership to inspect the brake pedal for a full return by using the Ford Diagnostic & Repair System (FDRS) scan tool and a manual review. If the brake pedal does not make a full return, the dealer will manipulate the system as described in the technical instructions. This service will be performed free of charge. The time needed for this repair is less than one-half day. However, due to service scheduling requirements, your dealer may need your vehicle for a longer period. In addition, your vehicle will require an inspection to determine if parts need to be ordered.

Please call your Ford dealer without delay and request a service date for recall 26C17. Provide the Ford dealer with your VIN, which is printed below in this letter. If you do not already have a Ford service dealer, you can access ford.com/support for dealer addresses, maps, and driving instructions. **If you already had Ford recall 26C17 performed, disregard this Chassis Advisory Notice.**

This Notice Applies to Your Vehicle, Vehicle Identification Number (VIN): XXXXXXXXXX

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Ford Motor Company has decided that certain 2025 - 2026 F53/F59 Stripped Chassis Vehicles with the Hydro-Boost Brake System including the VIN shown above, fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 108 Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment.

We apologize for this situation and want to assure you that, with your assistance, we will correct this condition. Our commitment, together with your dealer, is to provide you with the highest level of service and support.

- What is the issue?** It is possible that your vehicle's brake pedal may not fully return to the rest position after being depressed. As a result, the stop lamps may remain illuminated when the brakes are not in use.
- What is the risk?** Stop lamps that illuminate when the brakes are not in use can increase the risk of a crash.
- What will Ford and your dealer do?** Parts are available to repair your vehicle. Ford Motor Company has authorized your dealer to inspect the brake pedal for a full return by using the Ford Diagnostic & Repair System (FDRS) scan tool and a manual review. If the brake pedal does not make a full return, the dealer will manipulate the system as described in the technical instructions. This service will be performed free of charge.
- How long will it take?** The time needed for this repair is less than one-half day. However, due to service scheduling requirements, your dealer may need your vehicle for a longer period of time. In addition, your vehicle will require an inspection to determine if parts need to be ordered.
- What should you do?** Please call your dealer without delay and request a service date for Recall 26C17. Provide the dealer with your VIN, which is printed near your name at the beginning of this letter.
- Ford has not issued instructions to stop driving your vehicle under this compliance recall. You should contact your dealer for an appointment to have your vehicle remedied as soon as practicable.
- If you do not already have a servicing dealer, you can access ford.com/support for dealer addresses, maps, and driving instructions.
- Ford Motor Company wants you to have this compliance recall completed on your vehicle. The vehicle owner is responsible for making arrangements to have the work completed.
- Please note: Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.**

What should you do? (continued) NOTE: You can receive Information about Recalls and Customer Satisfaction Programs through our Ford App. The app can be downloaded through the App Store or Google Play. In addition, there are other features such as reserving parking in certain locations and controlling certain functions on your vehicle (lock or unlock doors, remote start) if it is equipped to allow control.

Mobile Service Ford Mobile Service is offered by participating dealers, contact your dealer for details.

Have you previously paid for this repair? If you have previously paid for a repair that addresses the issue described in this letter, you still need to have this recall performed to ensure the correct procedures were used.

You may be eligible for a refund of previously paid repairs. Refunds will only be provided for service related to a brake pedal that does not make a full return when released. To verify eligibility and expedite reimbursement, give your paid original receipt to your dealer.

Refund requests may also be sent directly to Ford Motor Company. To request your refund from Ford, send the refund request with all required documentation, including your original repair receipt (no photocopies), to Ford Motor Company at PO Box 6251, Dearborn, Michigan 48121-6251. Refund requests mailed to this address may take up to 60 days to process. Your original receipt will be returned to you.

Detailed information regarding eligibility for Ford's reimbursement program and documentation requirements may be obtained by contacting the Ford Recall Assistance Center at 1-866-436-7332.

What if you no longer own this vehicle? If you no longer own this vehicle and have an address for the current owner, please forward this letter to the new owner.

You received this notice because government regulations require that notification be sent to the last known owner of record. Our records are based primarily on state registration and title data, which indicate that you are the current owner or lessee.

Can we assist you further? If you have difficulties getting your vehicle repaired promptly and without charge, please contact your dealership's Service Manager for assistance.
