Re: Product Update: 2026 Accord, Accord Hybrid Monroney Label Misdescription

Today, May 1, 2026, American Honda is announcing a **product update** for certain 2026 Accord and Accord Hybrid vehicles shipped with Monroney labels that have incorrect safety ratings and/or transmission country of origin. The vehicles themselves comply with applicable regulations but the information on the Monroney labels does not. **Perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

REPAIR

All vehicles in dealer stock that are affected by the erroneous Monroney labels must have a corrected replacement Monroney label applied. Already sold to retail customers vehicles do not require any action and are ineligible for the Product Update.

PARTS/LABEL INFORMATION

There are no vehicle parts or materials associated with this product update. Your dealership Service Manager will receive a package directly from American Honda Motor Co., Inc. with the corrected labels. Check the VIN on the labels with your dealer new vehicle stock and replace labels to unsold units ONLY. If needed, additional labels can be ordered through your District Sales Manager.

TOOLS

There are no special tools needed for this campaign.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service Bulletin 26-063, *Product Update: 2026 Accord, Accord Hybrid Monroney Label*, has posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of May 1, 2026. It includes labels, repair, and warranty information related to this campaign.
