Product Update: 2026 Integra Monroney Label (Including Type S)

BACKGROUND

Certain 2026 Integra and Integra Type S vehicles shipped with incorrect safety ratings on the Monroney Labels. The vehicles are in compliance; the Monroney Label information is not.

Do an iN VIN status inquiry to make sure the vehicle is shown as eligible.

Vehicles affected by this campaign may be in your new vehicle inventory. Repair these vehicles before they are sold.

No action is required for vehicles that have already been sold. For vehicles already sold, send a Campaign Status Change Request form to update the unit.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Remove the original Monroney Label from the window and replace it with the Monroney update label.

PARTS INFORMATION

There are no vehicle parts or materials associated with this Product Update. Your dealership Service Manager will receive a package directly from American Honda with the corrected labels.

Check the VIN on the labels with your new vehicle stock and replace the labels to unsold units **ONLY**. If needed, additional labels can be ordered through your District Sales Manager.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

1. Confirm the vehicle's VIN matches the VIN on the **new** Monroney Label.
2. Remove the original Monroney Label from the left rear interior window.
3. Remove any remaining adhesive residue from the window.
4. Clean the window using isopropyl alcohol and a clean shop towel. Allow to dry.
5. Install the **new** Monroney Label in the same location as the original.

NOTE: If necessary, bring the vehicle indoors to allow the window to reach room temperature; otherwise the label may not adhere properly to the glass.
