OUT1 Software Update Content:

This update delivers functional improvements to connectivity, Apple CarPlay, Android Auto, cyber security, infotainment, and navigation. It also improves overall software stability.

Information for Dealers:

The OUT1 code is visible on ALL vehicles eligible to receive the OTA update.

Dealers are not required to perform any work.

Please note that the OUT1 may be displayed in ELSA before the over-the-air update is deployed to a vehicle and visible to the customer.

The software is being deployed to vehicles in waves, and owner notification will be done in waves as well. See Appendix A for screen captures of what the customer will see.

- The software update is announced via the myAudi app, informing the customer an update will be available shortly.
- 24 hours after the customer receives this notification, the software will begin downloading to the vehicle in the background.
- Download progress will not be visible to the customer.
- Once the download is completed, the customer will receive additional notifications, this time in both the MMI & myAudi app, informing the customer that the update is ready for installation.
- The customer can then confirm and start the software update in the MMI.

Vehicles in new or CPO dealer inventory do not require the OUT1 OTA to be completed to process the sale. New customers may receive the OTA at a later date.

The following requirements must be met in order for the customer to complete the OTA update in their vehicle:

- The vehicle must be online.
- The vehicle must not be in privacy mode.
