Customer states:

After a period during which the vehicle is stationary, the instrument cluster view changes from the navigation map (Figure 1) to the rev counter (Figure 2).

Workshop findings:

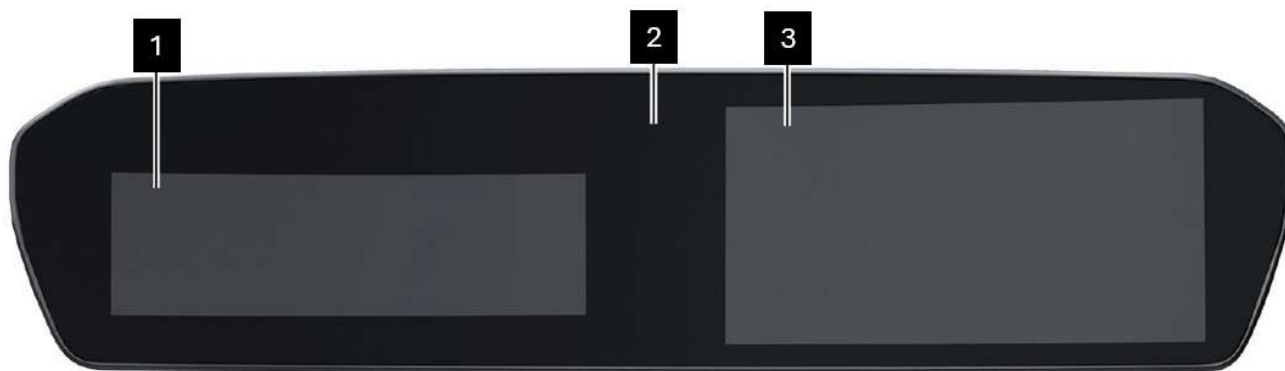


Figure 3. Panoramic display in left-hand drive vehicles (example; the layout is reversed in right-hand drive vehicles)

The instrument cluster (J1254, Figure 3) switches from the navigation map view (Figure 1) to the rev counter view (Figure 2) after a bus sleep cycle.

Instrument cluster view changes from navigation map to rev counter after bus sleep cycle due to design concept.

Production Solution

Design concept changed for model year 2027 with the introduction of a functional enhancement that takes into account the last instrument cluster view before a bus sleep cycle.
