A. Affected Vehicles:

VIN Identification: Vehicle will appear in the 'Campaign Not Performed' section. Use the 'Vehicle Information' screen in WebDCS to verify "Warranty Start Date" and ensure the vehicle is within New Vehicle Limited Warranty (NVLW), observing mileage prior to any repair work.

- Certain 2026MY G70 (IK) equipped with 2.5T or 3.3T engines produced 05/23/2026 - 06/10/2026
- Certain 2027MY G80 (RG3) equipped with 2.5 Turbo engines produced 06/02/2026 - 06/09/2026

B. Campaign Description:

Certain 2026MY G70 (IK) and 2027MY G80 (RG3) vehicles may exhibit a water-flowing or gurgling noise from the front center air vents during engine start-up. This condition may be caused by trapped air within the engine cooling system.

Technical Service Bulletin (TSB) 26-01-064G provides instructions to properly bleed the cooling system and remove any trapped air.
