- The customer complains about cracking or creaking noises when steering that come from the front end in the area of the steering column/intermediate steering shaft/steering rack/steering wheel. This service info is intended to help you narrow down the cause of the noise.

Technical Background

Noises from dynamic steering actuator due to tolerances.

Production Solution

Gradually for different models.

Service

To narrow down the source of the noise, proceed as follows:

- Remove the fuse for the dynamic steering, J792 (address word 001B). This disables the actuator.
- If the noises no longer occur when steering, the dynamic steering actuator is the cause of the noises that were heard previously.
- If the noises persist, continue investigating other components of the steering system and the steering column switch module.
